At Trinity, we recognise the significant commitment families make to provide their sons with a Trinity education.

The School remains committed to our all-inclusive approach to fees including:

- ▲ ICT devices: commencing 2026, we introduced a Trinity-managed device program for Year 7 students, providing a consistent and secure platform for learning as boys begin their Middle School journey¹

FLEXIBLE PAYMENT PLANS FOR YOUR TUITION FEES

While we offer several avenues for fee payment, families are encouraged to set up a Payment Plan via the Fee Payment portal for the year ahead. This allows you to spread payments evenly throughout the year providing greater flexibility.

The ability to set up a Payment Plan will be made available once you receive notification that your School Fee Statement is available.

We anticipate all fee statements will be made available to families on the 23 January 2026.

Payment Plan Schedule Options

- ▲ One **Annual** Payment
 - Payment due 27 February 2026
- ▲ Four **Termly** Payments
 - First instalment due 16 February then every 3 months
- ▲ **Fortnightly** Payments (Alternating Weeks)
 - Option 1: 24 payments commencing 29 January 2026
 - Option 2: 24 payments commencing 5 February 2026
- ▲ **Monthly** Payments
 - Option 1: 11 payments commencing 2 February 2026
 - Option 2: 11 payments commencing 16 February 2026
- ▲ **Weekly** Payments
 - 48 payments commencing 29 January 2026

THE TRINITY BUILDING FUND

Together, We Build More Than Walls

Our School is more than classrooms—it's a community. When you contribute to the Building Fund, you're helping create spaces where friendships grow, ideas flourish, and boys feel they belong.

Trinity families continue to give generously to the Voluntary Building Fund annually. Through this, significant improvements have been delivered during 2025. At Summer Hill, Science laboratories and TAS classrooms have been refurbished. At Strathfield, a new playground at the Preparatory School has been completed. These projects reflect our continual improvement commitment to the built educational landscape of your sons, the most significant of which is the Summer Hill Renewal Project. We hope to be using at least some of the new and refurbished facilities in Term 4 2026, with the project completed for 2027.

A voluntary Building Fund contribution can be set up at the same time as setting up your School Fee Payment Plan, following the same flexible payment plan schedule.

Example:

- ▲ One **Annual** Contribution: \$500
 - ▲ Four **Termly** Payments of \$125
 - ▲ **Fortnightly** Payments (Alternating Weeks)
 - Option 1: 24 payments commencing 29 January 2026 of \$20.83
 - Option 2: 24 payments commencing 5 February 2026 of \$20.83
- ▲ **Monthly** Payments
 - Option 1: 11 payments commencing 2 February 2026 of \$45.45
 - Option 2: 11 payments commencing 16 February 2026 \$45.45
 - ▲ **Weekly** Payments
 - 48 payments commencing 29 January 2026 of \$10.42

We are delighted so many of our Trinity families have donated to and supported this important fund. Thank you.

All contributions made to the School's Building Fund are tax-deductible. A receipt for contributions to the Building Fund will be issued early in July 2026.

Non-refundable Enrolment Fee	To be paid as acceptance of an enrolment offer. This fee is directed towards the improvement of the facilities of the School over the duration of the student's enrolment. It also includes a component for the life-membership subscription for the Old Trinitarians Union.	\$5,000.00*

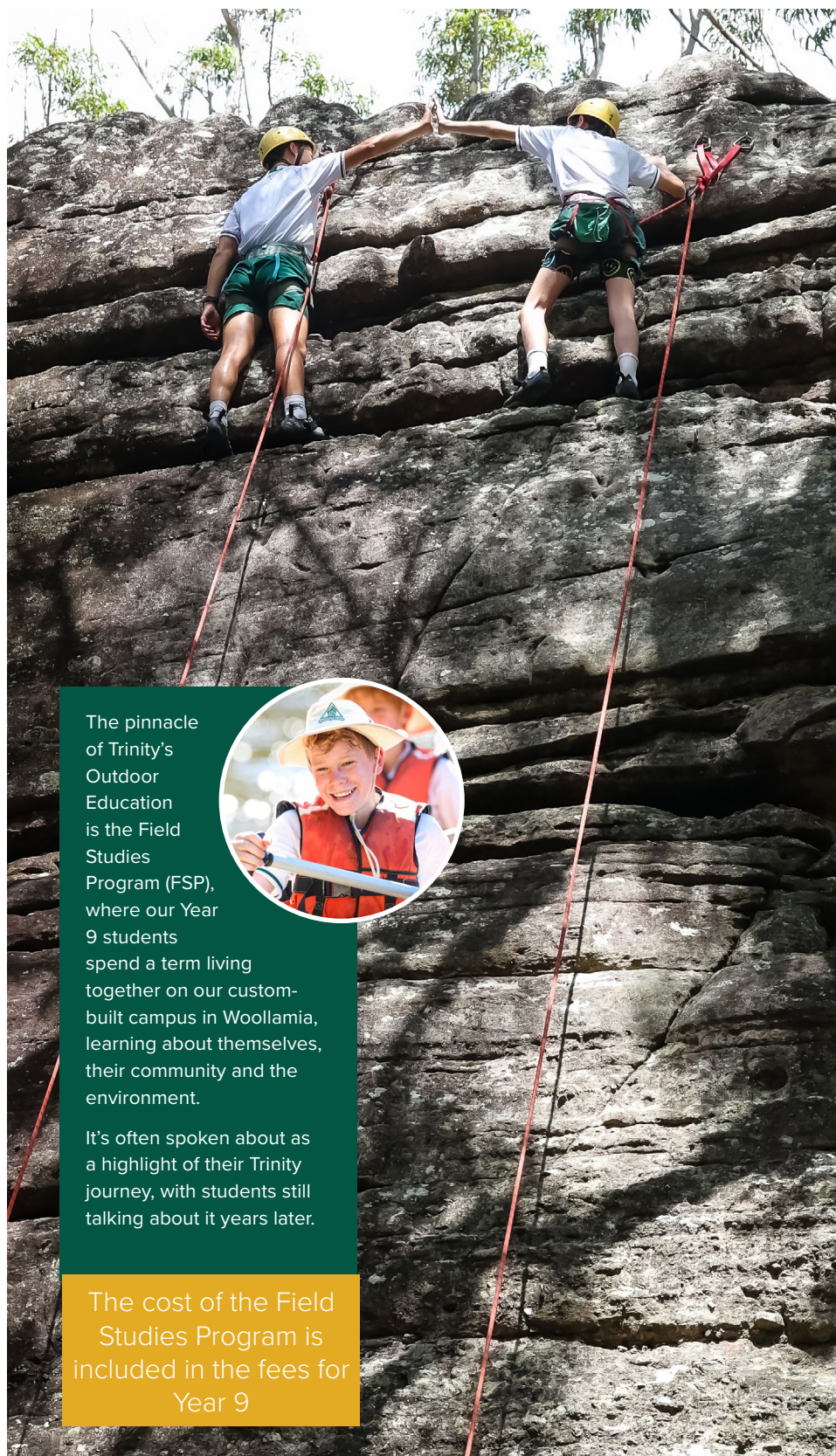

NOTES: * In addition to the normal schedule of fees and charges.

1. Tuition fees will be charged annually at the beginning of each year.
2. The School Council has directed that the tuition fees can be paid in one payment at the start of the year, or in equal weekly, fortnightly, monthly or termly instalments, provided the instalment amounts would clear the fees owing by the end of that calendar year. Unless an appropriate payment plan in accordance with the above has been put in place, a student's enrolment will be discontinued.
3. Ancillary fees, levies, charges and other amounts that become payable to the School will be invoiced quarterly with payment due within 21 days from the date of the invoice.
4. A full term's notice - in writing and addressed to the Headmaster - is required of intention to withdraw a boy from the School. A full term's fee is charged for withdrawal without such notice.
5. A discount is allowed for brothers who attend the School at the same time:
 - ▲ 5% for the second son
 - ▲ 15% for the third and subsequent sons
6. An administration fee of \$50 will apply to fees where an instalment arrangement is in default and the School has cause to issue a notice concerning the outstanding fees.
7. Recovery of Payment Processing Fees. The School reserves the right to recover any fees, charges, or percentages imposed by third-party payment processing platforms (including but not limited to credit card processors and online payment gateways) in connection with the payment of School fees. Such amounts will be charged back to the payer at the same rate applied by the processing platform and will be added to the total amount payable.
8. The Building Fund donations are fully tax-deductible and specifically used for building improvements.
9. All fees are reviewed annually. Over the last decade, tuition fees have increased between 3% and 9% per annum. Similar increases should be expected into the future.
10. For payment of School Fees in advance, please contact the Bursar.
11. The School does not offer extended payment terms. Extension of fee payments is available via Edstart.
