



Schedule of Fees 2026

This Schedule of Fees is provided to parents in accordance with, and should be read in conjunction with The King's School's Conditions of Enrolment, which are available at <https://www.kings.edu.au/the-kings-school-policies>.

The King's School provides a broad range of academic, extra and co-curricular opportunities. The majority of these activities are included in the tuition fees below and all boys are encouraged to participate in order to maximise their King's experience. Separate fees are charged for items such as technology, textbooks, stationery, excursions, camps and VET subjects, as indicated below. Parents will be advised of any additional charges as part of accepting the additional goods or services being provided.

Note: Educational expenses including tuition are generally exempt from GST. The School reserves the right to charge GST for goods and services where exemptions do not apply, e.g. GST is applicable to the food component of boarding fees.

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ADDITIONAL COSTS

In addition to the tuition fees, an Excursion and Amenities Levy for Pre-Kindergarten to Year 6 is charged to cover excursions and activities. The levy does not cover school camps and overnight excursions which will be charged separately. This charge varies depending on the activities conducted by the Preparatory School. It will be included in the first invoice of the school year.

Camps	Years 5 - 6	Excursions and camps are part of the NSW School Curriculum and are therefore compulsory. Camp fees are charged to meet the costs of overnight camps including material supplied to students for the camp. Parents will be separately advised of the final costs, which are usually included in the fee invoice by Term 2.
Music and other extra curricular activities, functions and events	Pre-Kindergarten – Year 12	Parents will be advised of the additional charges for each activity, function or event.
Bus Services	Kindergarten – Year 12	Daily King's operated services run across the Sydney metropolitan region – refer to website for current service offering. \$529 per term.
Uniforms	Pre-Kindergarten – Year 12	Full school regulation uniform (including Sports uniform) - approximately \$2,150 initial cost.
Cadet Corps Uniform	Year 8	Approximately \$375 initial cost.
Occasional Boarding	Years 7 – 12	Occasional boarding, which is up to three nights per week, is charged at \$180 per day.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

Sibling concessions are calculated on the number of children from the same household who are attending the School at the same time. Concessions are calculated based on the number of siblings in the one family and where the fees are being paid by the same fee-payer. Sibling concessions do not apply to a child holding a Scholarship or any other form of remission but usually do apply to his brothers.

TAX-DEDUCTIBLE GIVING

To assist with continuing to improve the School's infrastructure, and reduce fee increases, we request families make a regular tax-deductible contribution to the School's Building Trust and Scholarship Trust. The suggested amount is \$245 per term or \$980 per year. These contributions are gratefully received and improve the facilities provided to students.

REGISTRATION AND ENROLMENT FEES

All registration and enrolment fees are non-refundable and are not credited towards tuition fees.

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PAYMENT OF FEES, ADDITIONAL FEES AND DISBURSEMENTS

Fees may be paid:

- (1) Termly – Fees are due and payable in full two weeks prior to the first day of each term; or
- (2) Eligible parents/guardians may apply to the School to pay their fees via direct debit in regular instalments as set out in the annual Fee Schedule. Parents / guardians are only eligible to participate in this option if they are fully up to date with their account. Failure to maintain payment of instalments will result in the full term's fees becoming due and payable immediately, and no longer being eligible for the instalment program.
- (3) Ten monthly direct debit billing (February - November) by credit card (MasterCard, Visa or American Express payments attract a 1.3% charge on the amount paid), or nominated savings account.

The King's School will issue invoices for termly payment of fees. All fees are shown and billed in Australian dollars only. For security reasons the School does not accept cash for payment of fees.

Online fees and account payments can be made via The King's School website at: <https://payment.kings.edu.au>. A credit card surcharge applies based on the fees the School is charged. Payments made via BPAY receive no additional charge.

LATE PAYMENT OF FEES

Fees are due and payable as and when instalments fall due. The Council appreciates that the great majority of parents comply with these payment terms.

A student will not be able to commence a new term whilst fees remain outstanding, and students will not be permitted to participate in any discretionary activity offered by the School.

A default charge of \$250 per term will be applied to fees not paid within 21 days of rendering the account. This amount reflects the administrative and financial costs of collecting outstanding fees and charges and represents a genuine pre-estimate by the School of the loss that it would suffer if the required notice is not provided.

EXTENSION OF FEE PAYMENTS

The School has partnered with Edstart to provide additional payment options for school fees. Edstart is available to families who would like more flexibility with their school fees, including the option to reduce your annual payments by spreading them over a longer period.

WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS

Parents must give at least one full term's notice in writing to the School to terminate the student's enrolment. Notice must be received and acknowledged by the School no later than the last day of the preceding term. For example, where it is intended that a student's enrolment will terminate at the end of Term 4, written notice must have been received by the School and acknowledged as having been received no later than the last day of Term 3. In the absence of the required notice, a term's fees (tuition and boarding, where applicable) are immediately payable. These amounts are a genuine pre-estimate by the School of the loss that it would suffer if the required notice is not provided.

Payments made to The King's School are not refundable.
