FEES STRUCTURE FOR 2025 - 2026

Dear Parents,

As the Class of 2025 completes their final examination papers, we are proud of their diligent work ethic and wish them every success at leading universities on both sides of the Atlantic in August. Indeed, these students carry on the Brookhouse tradition of impressive academic results and entry to the finest Ivy league and Russell Group universities.

Outlined below are the fees for Brookhouse for the next academic year, 2025 – 2026, for both campuses, Karen and Runda. In determining the fee schedule for the coming year the Board has considered input from parents, prevailing economic conditions in East Africa and rises in all areas of operational costs over the last 12 months.

By way of context, the average fee increase at Brookhouse for the past several years has been in the vicinity of 6-10% annually, with last year being at 7%. **For the 2025-2026 academic year, the overall average fee increase is 6.5%.** However, you will note that for 70% of the Year groups the increase this year is closer to an average of 5%.

Please note the following:

1. Fees are payable in three equal termly instalments – due on 1st September 2025, 5th January 2026 and 20th April 2026.
2. For the candidate classes (Year 11 and Year 13) fees are payable in two equal instalments - due on 1st September 2025 and 5th January 2026.
3. Fees for International Foundation Year (IFY) is payable in two equal instalments - due on 5th January 2026 and 20th April 2026.
4. A monthly instalment plan is available and you may contact the Deputy Director, Ms Clara Mwangi for more information on this payment option.

The school continues to invest in academic resources and IT infrastructure and works diligently to retain the highest calibre teaching staff. We are pleased that again this year staff recruitment has been successful in ensuring continuity of first-class educational delivery.

PAYMENT METHODS

As before, fees are quoted only in Kenyan shillings. However, parents are welcome to make their payments either in Kenyan shillings or US dollars. Parents are requested to select whichever currency most suits their circumstances for payments. As a standard procedure those choosing to pay in US dollars will be advised of the current exchange rate at the time of payment.

Year 11 and 13 fees are payable in two equal instalments, due on 1st September 2025 and 5th January 2026.

IFY fees are payable in two equal instalments, due on 5th January 2026 and 20th April 2026.

Important information about school fees: -

1. **The above fees include** lunch, textbooks and exercise books but do NOT include registration fee and examination fees.
2. **Enrolment applications** are only processed upon the return of the completed Registration form with all supporting documents and payment of a non-refundable Registration fee of Kshs. 50,000/=.
3. **Mode of all payments:** direct deposits / swift transfers in the school bank accounts, details as provided in the fees statement/invoice. Cheques and cash payments are not accepted.
4. **Fees are payable on or before the first day of each term.**
5. **Early payment discount:** a discount of 2% on tuition fees is provided when full year payment is made before the start of the academic year.
6. **A late payment penalty** of 2% is charged for the late payment of fees - commencing 2 weeks after the start date of term.
7. **Trips and activities** are charged separately and are normally accompanied by an official letter from the School.
8. **A full term's notice in writing is required for all withdrawals or a full term's fees is payable in lieu of such notice before any final clearance documents are issued by the school.**

Additional fees: -

The tuition cost includes all textbooks and some stationery.

The student is expected to provide some items of equipment as listed in the school handbook.

Please note: information regarding transport fees for bus service will be communicated by separate letter.

In some subjects residential field courses are offered. There will be an additional cost for these only to cover the cost of transport, food and accommodation. Other optional activities and clubs are offered at an extra cost and require a weekly or termly payment.
